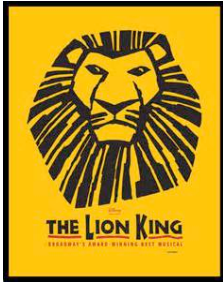
Although the meeting was poorly attended the Cider and Cheese tasting was excellent.
